## Terms of Consignment

1. An entry form should be completed for each lot together with the correct entry fee.
2. In the event that the Vendor wishes to place a reserve on a lot, the amount must be specified on the entry form.
3. All purchasers and vendors are deemed to have full knowledge of the “***LAA Conditions Of Sale***” and purchasers to have heard and understood the Auctioneer's description of the lot.
4. The Auctioneer may refuse, without giving a reason to accept either entries or bids.
5. Each lot shall be entirely at the owners risk until the fall of the hammer at which point it is the responsibility of the Purchaser. The Auctioneer will not be responsible for loss, injury or death of an animal or article on the Sale premises.
6. The highest bidder shall be the purchaser and in the event of a dispute the lot shall be re-offered.
7. Neither the Vendor nor the Purchaser of a lot shall have any remedy against the Auctioneer in respect of a lot. The Auctioneer acts only as an agent inviting bids for the lot, but will supply names and addresses of principals on request by either in the event of a dispute.
8. Any lot bought in by any person other than the owner will be treated as sale and commission charged. The vendor has the right to place a reserve on each lot.
9. If any purchaser fails to comply with these or any other Conditions the lot in question may be re-offered and if upon resale a lower price is obtained than when first sold then the shortfall as well as expenses incurred shall be liability of the purchaser in default on the first sale.
10. Sales can be made privately providing that the animal has first been offered by Auction and the sale is booked through the Auctioneers and the commission deducted.
11. Should any lot not be sold by auction the Auctioneers reserve the right on the sale day to negotiate the sale of that lot by private treaty to interested party at the reserve price of the lot without reference to the seller.
12. The Auctioneers do not give any warranty as the seller's title or good right to sell save that the entry has been accepted by the Auctioneer in good faith and without express knowledge of any default in the seller's title.
13. Any lot taken from the sale before payment will be treated as stolen and the matter reported to the police.
14. All animals and poultry must be penned and caged by 9.30 on the day of sale.
15. All working dogs must be microchipped – failure to provide necessary details of the dog will result in the animal not being offered for sale.
16. Cages supplied for the poultry/rabbits/guinea pigs. Vendors must bring own cage for working dogs.
17. Vendors are responsible for supplying water and feed for all animals prior to sale.
18. All cattle must be sold with a BCMS passport.
19. All sheep must be ear tagged correctly and accompanied by a movement licence.
20. All pigs must be ear tagged / tattooed or herd marked and accompanied by a licence or movement documentation on the day of sale.
21. Strictly entries of livestock only on the day of sale between 8.00am – 9.30am.
22. No machinery / tools on the day of sale – all implements and machinery items must be delivered between **9.00am – 12noon on Friday 20<sup>th</sup> September, 2019.**
23. Commission @ 5% + VAT (Minimum charges: Working Dogs @ £10 per head, Sheep @ £5 per lot, Cattle @ £25 per head, Fur & Feather @ £1.50 per cage).
24. Commission for Produce & Forage @ 15% up to £100, £100 and over @ 10%.
25. Entry fee for all lots is £2.60 including VAT (excluding produce and eggs) and must be paid on return of entry form.
