Sheep will be sold in catalogue order unless any alteration is authorised and announced by the Auctioneers. Private sales of sheep must not take place unless first offered for sale in the auction and then the sale must be made through the auctioneers.

Pens will be allocated on the day by the Gaerwen Auction Centre. Sheep must be penned before 9:30 am

The market will begin selling at 11 am and the sale of Wiltshire Horn Sheep will follow the Easycare sale

Conditions of Sale

The sale is held subject to the usual conditions of sale of the Livestock Auctioneers Association.

Settlement and Clearance

BREED STANDARD

Male and Female Horned

Horn falling back with uniform graceful curve clear of the head. In the male a stronger horn and with a second curve, which makes a picturesque adornment characteristic of the breed.

Head Ears Inclined to be long and broad

Face Wide and of medium length; pure white in colour

Eyes Big, bright, quick, prominent and fearless

Nose Wide nostril, with the flesh part of the nose preferably dark, with a roman

profile.

Teeth Strong and set into a good strong under jaw free from any sign of weakness **Neck**

Medium length. In rams wide at the poll and back of ears, and gradually

en-

larging in all lines to a strong full junction at the shoulder as seen from the sides or bottom. Ewes lighter and more feminine.

Ribs Well sprung with a full heart
Chest Deep, with a well filled brisket

Shoulder Wide and Oblique

Back & Loin Long and level, well covered with flesh. Tail broad and well set up.

Legs Forelegs straight and wide apart. Hind legs full of meat to a well angled hock with

good flat bone, with strong pasterns and sound feet.

Underline Good straight, naked

Skin Pink in colour and covered with short, kemp wool which falls as the sheep gains

condition in early spring.

Colour White, black ticks are permitted

Weights Live weight of rams 126kgs, ewes 72kg

General summary

Proud and stately on short legs with a certain grandeur of carriage. Pronounced masculinity in male and ewes feminine in appearance

How To Judge A Good Wiltshire Horn Sheep

(Male & Female Horned)

Before you start

Stand back and have a good look at the sheep from a distance. Get a general impression of the ram or ewe you may be interested in buying, appearance, poise, etc. Pay close attention to how it walks.

The sheep needs to be healthy with length, width and depth of body; she needs to eat, walk and feed two lambs. So the order of checking is:

- 1) Teeth eating is essential
- 2) Feet need to be able to walk to find food
- 3) Udder to rear two lambs
- 4) Testes in a breeding ram

Remember: to handle animals at the key points:

Shoulders

- ✓ Wide, well covered shoulders
- × Narrow, lacking flesh

The Body

- ✓ Good length, width and depth, level back
- √ Naked underline
- Short, narrow and lacking depth
- Excess fat, evident around tail & brisket

Mouth

The Head

colour

✓ Clean mouth with no signs of wear and no gaps

√ Roman nose; nostrils dark in

curving clear of the head

✓ Horns even, well spaced,

Short broad head

- √ Good 'bite' of incisor teeth against the pad of upper jaw
- Bite over or under shot
- 'Broken mouth' with signs of wear/gaps/teeth fallen out indicating an older sheep

Hair Coat ('skin')

- Short even growth of hair coat which sheds completely.
- ✓ White, black ticks are permitted
- Woolly fleece
- Partially shed hair coat

Udder – female

- Sound, supple udder and two wellplaced teats
- Swellings, hard lumps or sores
- Excessively large teats

Testicles - male

- ✓ Two even testicles
- Lumps

Feet

- Deep heel with short hooves
- ✓ Well sprung pasterns
- Lame feet
- Slack pasterns

Legs

- ✓ Strong boned, placed on each corner of ewe
- Bent or twisted legs
